Under the curriculum of third year, Students get the knowledge of concepts, nature and significance of organizational behavior. This course also provides the basic knowledge of Indian panel code 1860: main provisions jurisdictions, General explanations, punishments, Criminal Conspiracy, offences:- Bailable and non-Bailable offences, Cognizance and non – cognizable offences, Summons case, warrant case, duties of public prosecutor etc.
